<b>Activity</b>	<b>Experiences and Outcomes link</b>	<b>What it involves!</b>
<b>Farm Safety!</b> (+15 mins, compulsory at beginning of visit)	HWB 0-16a - 2-16a, SCN 1-13a	An interactive Health and Safety discussion about how to keep safe on the Farm and the measures that can be taken to reduce the spread of disease.
<b>Pond dipping!</b>	SCN 0-01a SCN 1-01a	Pupils will become Junior Scientists and investigate the diversity of species living in our pond.  This activity serves as a fun introduction to Biological sampling techniques and identification of species.
<b>Field to Fork!</b>	HWB 0-35a, SOC 1-09a, SCN 2-03a	Learn about where your food comes from!  Pupils will discover what makes an organic farm different to others.  P4-7 will also be introduced to the importance of fertilisers in farming.
<b>Building for Bugs!</b>	SCN 2-02a	Pupils will discuss and learn about the kind of places bugs like to live.  They will then be involved in the design and creation of their own bug hotel in our Enchanted Forest!
<b>Farm Food Chains!</b>	SCN 1-02a	Early years pupils will learn about the types of food our farm animals eat and why. There will also be an opportunity to feed some of our friendly residents in our all-weather Animal Barn!  Older years pupils will be introduced to the construction of food chains and learn how to build their own.
<b>Budding Gardeners!</b>	SCN 0-03a, SCN 1-03a	Learn about what makes a plant grow!  Pupils will develop their own area in our farm garden and get to 'pot a plant' to take back to school to study its requirements and growth.
<b>Scales and Tails!</b>	SCN 2-01a	Pupils will be given the opportunity to get 'hands on' with our special scaly friends (e.g. boa constrictor, bearded dragon, cockroaches) You will also have the chance to help us wash our Giant Tortoises!  Pupils will learn about how an animal's appearance is linked to its survival.

<b>Meet the Fluffies!</b>	SCN 2-01a	with some of our smaller residents (e.g. rabbits, guinea pigs, ferrets and rats. Chicks and ducks are seasonally available for handling.)  Pupils will learn about how an animal's appearance is linked to its survival.
<b>Full Farm Park Tour!</b>	SCN 0-01a	Enjoy a guided tour around our entire Farm Park and Animal Barn learning lots of interesting facts about our animals along the way!
<b>Tractor Trailer Ride!</b>	SCN 0-01a	Jump on-board our Tractor Trailer ride and enjoy an informative adventure around part of our Farm Park .
<b>Time to Play!</b>	HWB 0-25a, HWB 1-25a	Take some time for some free play in our Indoor PlayBarn and/or in our incredible Outdoor Adventure Playground!
